For undergraduate courses in our History and Sociology departments
for 2021W Term 1 (Sept-Dec 2021) and Term 2 (Jan-April,
2022)

Applicants enrolled as full-time students at UBC Okanagan will be given preference (a full-time student is defined as a minimum of 24 credits over the 2 terms of the 2021W Session). Preferred qualifications include **a strong understanding of the discipline**. Applications for UTA positions would be preferably students with 4th year standing who are HIST or SOCI majors. All applicants including international students must be permitted to work in Canada until at least April 30, 2022.

Teaching Assistants may be involved in the following:

- marking midterms, assignments, tests, quizzes and exams
- leading discussion periods and tutorials
- invigilating tests and examinations
- providing academic assistance to students during office hours
- various duties as appointed by the supervisor

The exact hours of these positions vary, but will not exceed 12 hours per week, Sept 1, 2021 - April 30, 2022. Successful candidates could be assigned duties in one or more undergraduate courses. These positions are subject to budgetary approval. Current wages for these positions are:

Graduate TAs (PhD Program) \$35.41 per hour
Graduate TAs (Master's Program) \$34.11 per hour
Undergraduate TAs \$18.68 per hour
